itelligence AG presents preliminary figures for Q1 2008

- **Orders on hand increase by 26.3% to MEUR 149.4**
- **Revenues improve 8.1% to MEUR 47.9**
- **Strong business in Germany and Western Europe, project delays in the USA and Eastern Europe**
- **EBIT reaches MEUR 1.6**

Bielefeld, April 24, 2008 – itelligence AG, one of the leading international full-service IT providers for SAP, again boosted its revenues in the first quarter of 2008. At MEUR 47.9, the Company increased its quarterly revenues by 8.1% year-on-year (previous first quarter: MEUR 44.3). itelligence AG's orders on hand continued to grow, climbing from MEUR 118.3 in the first quarter of 2007 to MEUR 149.4 in the first quarter of 2008 and were thus at the high level enjoyed at the end of 2007.

EBIT in Q1 2008 totaled MEUR 1.6 (Q1 2007: MEUR 2.6), resulting in an EBIT margin of 3.3% (Q1 2007: 6.0%). The decrease in earnings in the first quarter of 2008 is primarily due to project delays in the USA and Eastern Europe. itelligence expects to improve profitability in this region over the course of the year.

The Management Board confirms its forecasts for full year 2008. It expects revenues of between MEUR 210 and MEUR 214 (revenues in 2007: MEUR 190.9) and an EBIT margin of between 6.2% and 6.4% (EBIT margin in 2007: 6.0%).
